After we had coffee I went to the German mechanic who has a great reputation and whom I have used for years and reported Darlene's findings. He was very skeptical and said that it was highly unlikely. I told him that my experience with her as a remote viewer was that she was very accurate and I wanted him to check it out regardless of his doubt. He called me at the end of the day and reported that she was right in every detail and that my car was repaired. When I picked it up he was still shaking his head that someone could diagnose a car from a distance. I left them her card for future reference.
